This seminar will describe why and how to make your practice fear free by demonstrating and describing fear free protocols supported by scientific evidence, including how to recognize fear and anxiety, assess emotional health, prevent and alleviate fear and anxiety from travel to the hospital and home again, and how to manage pets that become fearful, anxious or aggressive during veterinary visits. The seminar will include multiple video examples of fear free strategies and fear free in action.

- What are the consequences of fear, anxiety and stress (FAS) on the pet, owner and veterinary team.

„Dr. Gary Landsberg received his DVM from the Ontario Veterinary College in 1976 and is a board-certified behaviorist of both the American and European colleges. He is currently the Vice President of Veterinary Affairs for CanCog Technologies, a consultant on VIN and works for Fear Free as Head of Research and a practice certification veterinarian and sits on their executive council. He is co-author of Behavior Problems of the Dog and Cat, co-editor of Canine and Feline Dementia, and Behavior section editor for Blackwell’s 5 minute veterinary consult. Dr. Landsberg received the companion animal behavior award from AAHA in 2000 and the meritorious service award from the Western Veterinary Conference in 2014.“
